

## ALTERNATIVE FUNDING BODIES

There are an enormous number of trusts and foundations who specifically support conservation and education programmes in general.

Many councils have lists of funding sources which support local projects – check your local authority's website. You should also see if there are any regional or European community development programmes into which your project could fall. Many commercial companies also have a charitable arm who may be willing to support you – particularly in places where they have local offices.

The list of trusts and foundations below has been culled from a variety of sources. We cannot guarantee that an application will be received favourably.

## **Guidance notes for applications:**

- 1. Contact the trust or foundation to establish whether there is an application form or a deadline or specific supporting information they require
- 2. Understand the trust or foundation's aims and ensure the application targets these. For example, the Heritage Lottery Fund is keen on

improving access and involvement with heritage, not simply preserving it.

- 3. Tailor each application for the trust or foundation there is nothing more off-putting than an application which looks like a mass mail out
- 4. Be clear about what you want, what you want it for and about the benefits for your project and the community at large
- 5. Be creative but not with the truth
- 6. Be enthusiastic
- 7. Be patient
